Historical Spotlight

The Zachariah Wines store built ca 1880 has shown the full effects of age and was in need of crucial repairs. Due to the generosity of funds provided by the Long Bluff Historical Society, several repairs have been made. The building remains a source of history and enjoyment for our community and for generations to come.

Born on November 12, 1847, Zachariah W. Wines, was the oldest son of Andrew and Susannah Wines. While attending college in Richmond, Va., Zachariah learned his father was encountering financial difficulties and was about to lose their land. Zachariah immediately left college and returned to Society Hill to help his father redeem their property. It was 1864, the country was in the throes of the Civil War.

A local merchant, educator, politician, and lay church leader Zachariah Wines, was born in 1847 in Society Hill, represented Darlington Co. in the S.C. House 1876 - 78, and was commissioned Captain in the National Guard in 1877. Wines was a founding member and officer of Union Baptist Church (organized in 1866). He also taught at nearby Waddell School and later served as Society Hill Postmaster, 1897-1904. He died in 1920. Wines was the First Black Businessman and Representative in Dar Co. As an update to the U.S. Hwys. 15-401-52 intersection improvements. The letting of the bid was acceptable and it was awarded sometime in October. The low bid was \$2.84 million, and when finished will add additional sidewalks towards Long Bluff Road on both sides of Main and at last make for safe turning lanes, especially for big trucks, to that intersection of U.S. Hwys. Also work has begun on the small solar farm on the outskirts of Society Hill. Besides providing safe renewable energy into the substation there it will add to the coffers of our town with an annual FILOT payment and of course the town will get considerable dollars from code in-
